## **Team Building Activities**

Outdoor Educational Services have been actively involved in arranging team building activities for schools, colleges & youth groups for a great many years, but often due to the temporary location of the site be it a playing field or other public accessible area some of the activities have to be very straightforward to set and have to be removed after use. As such, this is often at the expense of including more challenging, exciting & realistic activities often involving water, fixed ropes, poles, wooden structures and natural bush materials.

Outdoor Educational Services base is a 14 acre rural property just 25 minutes from the centre of Launceston at White Hills. Most of our Team Building Days have been at a school or in a location that we have been requested to set up our activities, we have, however, run one or two team building days for local schools here on our property. So successful has this been that we have decided to set up and develop a permanent team building & initiative course on our property together with some low & eventually some high rope elements as well.

Paul Grigg, the principal of Outdoor Educational services is no stranger to team games, initiative exercises & ropes courses having worked in several Outward Bound Schools, Commercial Outdoor Education Centres & three independent schools, all of which used these type of activities to great effect over the years.

Our site can potentially cater for groups of up to 80 students (working from a selection of up to 20 different challenges that vary in their difficulty depending on the nature & age of the group) We have ample parking for buses, some basic toilet facilities, a camp fire & barbecue site, & are building a picnic shelter for smaller groups (up to 24). We can also offer bush navigation/orienteering training as well.

In order to keep costs down we encourage groups to bring along your own staff & adult helpers. Where we have a problem solving activities that we deem as very low risk we will thoroughly explain & brief your staff on facilitating this activity. (This would normally be carried out at your school or college prior to the actual day of the event & then again immediately before the start of the days activities) Where we consider there is any potential inherent risk (for example where an activity is off the ground, involves participants being lifted or climbing) we will use our own trained facilitators.

Finally the success & more importantly the effectiveness of the activity day is directly proportional to the planning. It is essential, therefore, that we have the opportunity to liaise with the school, college or youth group organiser(s) to set the parameters & together agree on what you would like to achieve with your group.
