

HOW DO I BOOK

A minimum of 24 hours notice is required for all bookings. If you are booking a **DAY TOUR** you can do this in three ways :

- ◆ On line on our web site.
- ◆ Over the phone.
- ◆ Tasmanian Travel and Information Centre

Full payment is required at the time of booking.

PAYMENT METHODS

You can pay by Credit Card, Mastercard, Visa or Union Pay. Also WeChat Pay & Alipay (Book on WeChat and get a discount))



ONE WAY TRANSPORT

One way transport available for \$70.00 providing we have a minimum of 4 day tour passengers. You must contact us by telephone to be given instructions how to pay and use a different booking **form**. You will be required to pay in full by credit card.

MINIMUM NUMBERS

All our tours are subject to a minimum of 3 passengers on any journey. In the unlikely event that we do not receive sufficient numbers you will negotiate a special price or receive a full refund of any money paid.

MAXIMUM NUMBERS

Please phone us or check our "availability" on our web site to ensure we have sufficient space. Our Buses carry up to 13 passengers.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Over 21 days, full refund.
14—21 days, full refund less administration fee of \$20 per booking.
7—14 days, full refund less administration fee of \$10 per passenger.
2-7 days, \$50.00 per passenger will be charged
Less than 24 hours No Refund.

If due to circumstances beyond our control **we** have to cancel any journey or tour, you will receive a full refund.

If we are unable to complete a journey due to circumstances beyond our control such as weather, road conditions, or mechanical failure of one of our vehicles we will offer you a full refund or transfer your book-

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DEPARTURE TIMES FROM LAUNCESTON

We will pick you up from your accommodation providing it is in the city or suburb's close to the city. We commence picking up at **0715**. Please be outside your accommodation no later than 0705 we cannot go looking for you. We have various pickup points around the city so please be patient, you might be the last pick-up. If you have provided a phone number we will call you if we are running a little late. If you are not staying in a hotel we can pickup at the Transit Centre Cornwall Square (Cimitero Street). When booking you **must** tell us where you wish to be picked up from:

RETURN TIME

You can expect to be back in Launceston around approximately **1800 (6pm)**. Drop offs will be in the reverse order from pickup.

PLACES YOU CAN VISIT: Dove Lake, Glacier Rock, Marions Lookout & Crater Lake, Lake Lila, Wombat Pool, Ballroom Forest, Pencil Pine Falls & Rainforest Walk, King Billy Track, Enchanted Walk, Weindorfers Forest, Waldheim, Interpretation Centre (Ranger Station)

THINGS YOU MIGHT SEE: Wombats, Wallabies, Echidna (spiny ant eater), Platypus, Black Currawong, Black Cockatoo, Green Rosella.

THINGS YOU WILL SEE: Rain Forest Trees, Myrtle, Leatherwood, King Billy Pine, Celery Top Pine & Tasmania's only native deciduous tree Fagus. PLUS many flowering plants & shrubs

TOUR INCLUSIONS

Parks Pass, Free transport on the parks shuttle bus (if required) Picnic Lunch, Water & snacks for your journey.

NOT INCLUDED

Any additional food & drink at your expense.

WHAT YOU NEED TO WEAR

Cradle Mountain is in the highlands, it is a mountainous environment with sometimes unpredictable weather. Rain & snow can be experienced at any time of the year & temperatures can be up to 10 degrees lower than Launceston. Warm & waterproof clothing is essential. Footwear should preferably be sturdy with a good tread pattern. Open toed sandals & thongs (flip flops) are not suitable. Please see the additional information on our web site.

DRIVER GUIDES

Our drivers are chosen for their friendliness and local knowledge. For your safety please follow their instructions & advice

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Guided or Self-Guided? It is your choice—you can “do your own thing” Self Guided but within the time restraints available. Your driver will give you relevant information & tell you where and when to join the bus for the return to Launceston, the driver will know how long it takes to undertake particular walks and it is important you follow their advice—please do not be late back to the pickup point or the bus may leave without you. **OR** Guided your driver is also an experienced guide and he or she will take you to the most popular and interesting places as they know how long walks will take under the prevailing condition. This gives you the chance to ask questions and gain the maximum value from your tour. **Cautionary note:** this is a mountain environment & at times can be hazardous. Please ask our driver to explain any thing about which you are unsure. You should not leave the main tracks particularly if you are by yourself. You are advised to preferably walk with others. Do not attempt to head for Kitchen Hut or the summit of Cradle Mountain as you will **NOT** have time .

LOG BOOKS

If you decide to undertake any walks from Dove Lake you must complete the log book to say where you are going & the time of departure. You must sign the book again after your walk—**this is important.**

GETTING BACK TO THE BUS ON TIME

It is vital that you be back at the bus pick up points by the time that your driver has given you. If you do not have a watch then ask other visitors.

SAFETY

Walk with others & stay together. Always carry your water proof coat. Do not attempt too much. Beware of snakes during the summer months. Wear some Sun-screen and a hat. Carry water with you.

WHAT HAPPENS IF THE WEATHER IS BAD

If on arrival at Cradle Mountain the weather is unpleasant & unsuitable for walking the driver will take you to those places that you can either look around in the dry or are reasonably sheltered from the worst of the weather. In these circumstances we have a responsibility to keep you safe & you must not go off on your own or on any walks that the driver considers are too hazardous in the conditions.

If it is simply too cold & wet for people to enjoy the area then the bus will depart Cradle Mountain early & head for the Mole Creek area where there are other short walks & attraction that we feel you would be interested in.

BUSHWALKERS If you are staying at Cradle Mountain or undertaking the overland track you will be dropped at the Visitor Centre. It is your responsibility to purchase your own Parks Pass & if undertaking the overland track pick up your walking pass. If you have ordered fuel from us please be sure to ask the driver. If you are not sure where to go when you get there the driver will be glad to give you assistance.
